




# **Precinct Boundary Changes**



### **Proposed Ordinance**


- Change 4-11 to account for recent annexation
  - Requires change to 2-7
- Change 2-13 due to size
  - Adds new precinct 2-16

### Precincts 4-11 & 2-7



- Precinct 4-11 will continue south to 41<sup>st</sup> St., east of Six Mile Rd.
- Precinct 2-7's east boundary will remain Six Mile Rd.
- No voters currently impacted

# Campaign Finance

Ordinance 38.001: The provisions of state law on campaign finance applicable to state legislative office shall also apply to all elected municipal positions.

SDCL 12-27: Campaign Finance Requirements

#### **DEADLINES**

#### Deadline: Monday, January 6, 2020 (5 p.m.)

- Reporting Period: Last report through December 31, 2019
- Who Files: All Candidates and Candidate Campaign Committees

#### Deadline: Wednesday, February 5, 2020 (5 p.m.)

- Reporting Period: Last report through January 31, 2020
- Who Files: All Ballot Question Committees (Only)

#### Deadline: Wednesday, March 4, 2020 (5 p.m.)

- Reporting Period: January 1, 2020 (or last submitted report) through February 28, 2020
- Who Files: All Candidates, Candidate Campaign Committees, and Ballot Question Committees

#### Deadline: Thursday, April 9, 2020 (5 p.m.)

- Reporting Period: February 29, 2020 (or last submitted report) through April 6, 2020
- Who Files: All Candidates, Candidate Campaign Committees, Ballot Question Committees, and Political Action Committees\*

#### Deadline: Thursday, April 30, 2020 (5 p.m.) RUNOFF ELECTION ONLY

- Reporting Period: April 7, 2020 (or last submitted report) through April 27, 2020
- Who Files: Runoff Candidates/ Candidate Campaign Committees and Political Action Committees\*

#### Deadline: Wednesday, June 17, 2020 (5 p.m.)

- Reporting Period: April 7, 2020 (or last submitted report) through June 13, 2020
- Who Files: Candidates/ Candidate Campaign Committees and newly elected officials who did not have a runoff election and Ballot Question Committees
- Remarks: Submit this report as a Termination Statement

#### Deadline: Thursday, July 8, 2020 (5 p.m.) RUNOFF ELECTION ONLY

- Reporting Period: April 28, 2020 (or last submitted report) through July 4, 2020
- Who Files: Runoff Candidates/ Candidate Campaign Committees and newly elected officials
- Remarks: Submit this report as a Termination Statement.

### § 38.005 PERSONS AND ENTITIES REQUIRED TO SUBMIT CAMPAIGN FINANCE DISCLOSURES; TIME FOR SUBMISSION.

- (3) Candidates and candidate campaign committees shall have submitted a finance disclosure report by 5:00 p.m. within three business days following and complete through:
  - A. December 31 of the year prior to a city municipal election;
  - B. The last business day of February preceding the election in an election year;
  - C. The last Monday one week prior to the election;
- D. Sixty calendar days following the election for all candidates and newly elected officials who did not have a runoff and shall be considered the termination statement; and
- E. For runoff candidates, 60 calendar days following the runoff election and shall be considered the termination statement.
- (6) Public office holders for the city shall, not more than 15 days after the person assumes office and then not later than the first day of January of every year the person continues to hold the office, file a statement of financial interest setting forth any additions or corrections to any previous statement of financial interest filed pursuant to SDCL § 12-25-30.
